Modern pop artist and musical revolutionary, *ELEW*, will also take residence at Delano during Art Basel, entertaining guests with his own brand of Rockjazz in the lobby alongside Delano's Rose Bar. ELEW can be heard from Tuesday, December 4th through Saturday December 8th beginning at 11PM in the hotel's lobby.

Just two blocks away, Morgans Hotel Group's Shore Club will import some New York flavor for the festival by bringing back Matt Kliegman and Carlos Quirarte's *Westway* pop-up to the property's infamous RedRoom. The New York hipster-chic club, often visited by celebrities and scenesters including Mary-Kate Olsen and Kirsten Dunst, will return for its second year at Shore Club for Art Basel. *Westway* at RedRoom will open from Thursday, December 6th through Saturday December 8th at 11PM. This year, Kliegman and Quirarte are taking their talents to the day scene as well with their new *Westgay Pool Party* at Shore Club on December 8th from 4PM-11PM. The party will be hosted by *Frankie Sharp* with music by *The Scissor Sisters' Jake Shears*. Guests can also expect performances from *LE1F* and *Brooke Candy*.
